

CASA 311 Student Contract

I, _____, acknowledge that, as a student and community member of CASA 311, there will be rules and guidelines that I must abide by in order to achieve the greatest level of success in math class. CASA 311 strongly believes that **ALL** students can achieve and be successful. By participating in this plan, I will work diligently to earn a good academic standing and all of my goals.

1. I will not use my cell phone in school. I will not have it *out, on, in view, or in use*. This includes any electronic device, including cell phones, iPods or handheld game devices.
2. I will be respectful of everyone and everything at CASA, including: other students, teachers, administrators, custodians, any visitors and all materials, buildings and grounds (computers, etc).
3. I will actively participate in my own education by participating in class activities, maintaining a positive and cooperative attitude towards staff members, as well as, complying with requests made by any staff member. Failure to comply may result in restitution/ lunch detention.
4. I will comply with the school uniform every day. (No soccer pants, hoodies, etc.) Failure to comply will result in detention.
5. I will make an appointment to come for extra help if I don't understand the material, missed a day of class, or want to practice more.

Classroom Routines

Beginning of Period/Opening Meeting (10 to 15 minutes) ~

- Before entering the room, students will line up outside. Boys will stand next to the wall and girls a few inches apart from them. Enter the classroom **calmly and quietly**.
- Take out your homework notebook, folder, and pencil. *Copy your new homework assignment and have the previous night's homework ready to be checked.*
- Start working immediately by completing the warm up.
- The vocabulary and MLTP (mini lesson, teaching point) will be copied in the source books
- The beginning of the period is an important time for both student and teacher. Non academic issues may have to be addressed.

Middle of Period/Work Period (30 to 55 minutes) ~

- While lesson is being taught, students must copy ALL class notes and pay attention. Under no circumstance may a student stand up or talk without permission. Remember: Respect
- Students work in pairs or groups to complete in class assignments.

- Participation and discussions will occur. Be prepared to answer, defend and discuss your findings with your group members and entire classroom.
- During the work period is the **ONLY** time you will be permitted to use the restroom IF it is an emergency!

When you need help ~

- If we are doing group work, ask your **group members** (ask three before me). If your group members cannot answer your question, then you and your group members should raise your hands.

If you finish your work early, you can ~

- Help your group members.
- Review class notes.

End of Period/Closing Meeting (15 to 20 minutes) ~

- We will go over any work completed in class. Worksheets, task cards, math logs, or projects.
- The **teacher** will instruct you when it is time to pack up.
- Students in each group will work together to make sure all materials are returned to their proper positions in a neat and orderly fashion. No one is allowed to leave unless the room is in order.
- The **teacher** will dismiss the class by groups when the group is ready to be dismissed.
- Please push in your chairs as you get up to leave.
- Please throw out any garbage left behind on the floor or inside the desks on your way out.
- When given an **exit slip**, write your name, show all work and box your answer. You will be instructed on how to submit your slip. It maybe given directly to the teacher or posted on a wall as you exit. The exit slip is a time where you demonstrate your understanding of the day's lesson. There is absolutely no talking or sharing answers.

Homework ~

- Homework will be given 4-5 times per week. Homework must be completed online or homework workbook. You must show all of your work on a separate piece of paper when completing online homework so we can review it in class.
- You **MUST** copy down each problem and **show all necessary work** to receive credit for doing your homework.
- If you have missed an assignment or it is incomplete. I will complete my homework every night. If I am absent, I will reach out to a classmate and/or check the website/folders on "Were you absent?" to find the work I missed.

- **It is YOUR responsibility to make up the assignment and show it to me the next time homework is checked.**
